### Sewer Pump Repairs-Kings Mills

The repair costs for the Kings Mills grinder pumps have jumped due to foreign objects being flushed in the toilet, such as wipes. They are clogging and doing damage to the pumps. Notices will be sent to the residents of Kings Mills.

### DIRECTOR'S REPORT

#### Ground Water Evaluation Update

Exploration for water on the east side of the Northway has revealed the wells production would be similar to Jones Road and Mulberry well fields. Three wells would serve approximately 720 customers.

#### Waterline Extension to South East Side to Town

WWSA is looking into running a water line to the east side of town. By running a water line we would open up water to existing and future homeowners and businesses. The total cost of the project would be approximately \$650,000 plus contingencies.

Chairman Green asked for a motion to increase the budget in Capital Project #20 by \$20,000 to explore running a water line to the east side of town. The funds will come from an interfund transfer from the water fund. Secretary MacDougall offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

# **RESOLUTION # 13-21**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** to increase the budget in capital project #20 by \$20,000 to explore running a water line to the east side of town. The funds will come from an interfund transfer from the water fund.

The adoption of the foregoing resolution was seconded by Mark Moshier, duly put to a vote and the resolution was declared adopted with all Board members present voting in favor.

### Waterline Extension for Smith Bridge Subdivision

The water line will run behind Kelly's Deli, across Northern Pines Road and down Davidson Drive to the subdivision. The sewer may come from Jones Road.

### Water System Radio Upgrade Alarm System

We are working on replacing those radios. We have a bid that is within budget so it should be started soon.

# DOH Letter Regarding Floral Estates and Exit 15 City Water

The DOH has decided to treat the exit 15 area and Floral Estates 5 as separate water systems. That will require separate testing for each. If WWSA runs our own water lines the DOH will give us until 2014. If you do not run our own lines we will have to start testing in 2013.

#### Saratoga County Water Quality and Credit for Unused Water

We received a credit for 50% of our request for the time we turned off their water for \$14,000.

#### Online and Auto Bill Pay

We are working to upgrade to paperless billing. This will give our customers the choice of an ebill or a paper bill.

<u>Website Update</u> Spa Net is working on this.

<u>Annual Water Quality Report</u> This is complete and will be posted on our website and in the Wilton Report.
