Visit from Greenfield Fire District

Nate King from Greenfield Fire District discussed items for WWSA's consideration. Fire District would like to coordinate with WWSA re: NFPA color coding hydrants based on flow rate. The fire department would also like WWSA to consider extending water line from new construction pending at 628 Maple Ave to the firehouse on Maple Ave for a new training building. 628 Maple will be connected from the rear/Davidson Drive via an 8 in. water line, not on Maple Ave. Extending the 12 in. line from Dunkin Donuts to Maple Ave Middle School is 5900ft would be approximately \$745,000 and would pass 60 properties as potential future connections (\$46,000 per property), but perhaps grants and sharing costs between town, school and fire department could be explored to cover costs. The potential new development projects in that area (Valvoline, Cole's Collision) have been approved by building department to proceed with wells and septic

CVS Water Connection

CVS has connected to the water line for their fire protection system, but they are awaiting test from Northeast Fire Systems before line activated. The hydrants are activated and uncovered.

Collection of Past Due Water Bills

One of the two vacant properties with large outstanding water bills has accepted the offer of a bill accommodation of a 50% reduction in late fees and has paid off the remaining balance in full. The second property was offered the same accommodation of 50% reduction in late fees but missed the deadline and inquired with a counteroffer. Dennis will respond that the previous offer stands but if they need more time, the deadline could be adjusted.

Ballard Road Capital Project

Davidson Drive Water Line Loop

Full project completed in one week.

Davidson Drive Residents Want to Extend Water Line

Residents on other end of Davidson Drive think they have enough interested people to extend water line. A meeting with Director Mooney has been set up for September to discuss it further.

Water and Sewer Line Extensions for East Side of Northway

Negotiations continue with developers to create a special district for extension of water and sewer line by WWSA and costs to be repaid via individual property fees within the special district
