Bills

The total for the Water & Sewer Funds for January is \$309,292.08 and \$104,945.50 for the Capital Projects Fund.

Saratoga County Water Line Connection Progress and Change Order

The interior of the building is finished, the control components have been delivered and installed, and the electrical is almost done. The pavement, sidewalk, trees and grass will be done in the spring. 10% of the total contract will be held back until those items are complete in the spring. We should be ready by early February.

A change order to purchase and install a propane tank for \$3,143.95 needs to be approved which brings the total contract to \$249,492.93.

Chairman Fleming asked for a motion to approve the Saratoga County Water Line Connection project change order to purchase and install a propane tank for \$3,143.95 which brings the new general contract to \$249,492.93. Mark Moshier offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

If the customer gives us an e-mail address and e-mail will be sent out to them when payment has been made.

New Public Authorities Reform Act Review

On December 2, NYS passed the Public Authorities Reform Act of 2009. It's an update to the 2005 Act. We will include a statement in our annual report saying the changes do not affect

WWSA. Dennis Feeney has a copy and will review it and let the Board know what we need to do.

WWSA 2010 Fact Summary

Director Mooney distributed and updated the fact summary sheet to the Board Members.

Water Contract with City for Floral Estates Area

Nothing new on this contract.

Featherwood Water System

Nothing new to report.

County Water Authority Rebate for Connection

Waiting for the project completion to apply for the rebate.

Route 50 Retail Plaza

The project manager, Nigro Companies, owner Joel Aaronson submitted an application with the maximum number of units to be 10 EDUs and they paid for 10 EDUs. During a review of actual water used for that project Director Mooney discovered that EDUs should have been 21 EDUs. Therefore they owe WWSA for 11 EDUs or \$55,000. No further CO's will be issued until the \$55,000 is paid.

Water Line Break

On 1/15 over 18 feet of water line cracked on Aberdeen Way. At about 6:30 a.m. the water was shut off on that street. It was repaired by 2:00 p.m. This caused low water pressure and turbid water in the area.
